

# SCHOLARSHIPS 2011 - 2012

All scholarship applications are currently available in the Guidance office or online. Pay close attention to all deadlines. **Revised 3-30-2012.**

**GEAUGA COUNTY FARM BUREAU AGRICULTURAL LEADERSHIP AWARD.** Four \$1,000 scholarships given to an active Farm Bureau member or a family member who parent/guardian is an active member and has been a member for the past three years. 500-word essay required and criteria is activities, honors, community service, work experience. Applications are in Guidance and must be returned to the Geauga County Farm Bureau (either dropped off, emailed or mailed) to be **postmarked no later than April 1, 2012.**

**WOMEN IN SPORTS AND EVENTS CLEVELAND CHAPTER SCHOLARSHIP.** For women pursuing a degree in sports management, events management or related fields. Minimum 2.75 cumulative GPA and history of participation in sports management, sports/event volunteerism, or the business of sports or athletes such as coaching and team management. Applications in Guidance. **Must be postmarked by April 2, 2012.**

**WILLIAM D. SQUIRES EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION.** Fifteen renewable \$3,000/year scholarship given based on financial need, motivation, character, letters of recommendation and essay. Minimum 3.20 cumulative GPA. Download application on [www.wmdsquiresfoundation.org](http://www.wmdsquiresfoundation.org). **Must be postmarked by April 5, 2012.**

**KENSTON HIGH SCHOOL PTO SCHOLARSHIP.** Minimum cumulative 2.5 GPA, community service, school involvement and work experience. **Return to Guidance by April 13, 2012.** Late applications will not be accepted.

**MUSICAL ARTS ASSOCIATION OF KENSTON.** Five \$500 scholarships to seniors who are or have been a member of concert and/or marching band, chorus or Bomberettes. Requires essay. **Return application to Guidance by April 13, 2012.**

**BAINBRIDGE FIRE DEPARTMENT.** Must plan to pursue a degree in public service (i.e., law, education, medicine, social services, political science, fireman, policeman, etc.). Must have a varsity letter in at least one sport during high school and be committed to an extracurricular activity for two years year-round or four years seasonal, and active in the community. Applications are in Guidance and **must be returned to Guidance by April 13, 2012.**

**BAINBRIDGE POLICE DEPARTMENT.** Two \$1,000 scholarships given. Qualifications include 2.5 cumulative GPA or above, accepted to a college, plan to major in the field of public service (i.e. law, medicine, education, sociology, psychology, military, other), typed 500-word essay, transcript. Applications are in Guidance and **must be returned to Guidance by April 13, 2012.**

**UH GEAUGA MEDICAL CENTER AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP.** \$1,000 offered to a senior who intends to pursue a degree in health care. Essay and official (sealed) transcript required. Applications in Guidance. **Must be MAILED to be RECEIVED by Friday, April 13, 2012.**

**BAINBRIDGE COMBINED SERVICE SCHOLARSHIP – BAINBRIDGE CIVIC CLUB – AREA FOOD FOR FRIENDS – JOEL JOHNSON MEMORIAL – DON TAKACS MEMORIAL.** Four scholarships, one application. Applications are in Guidance and **mail to be received by April 15, 2012.**

**GEAUGA COUNTY TOUCHDOWN CLUB SCHOLARSHIP.** Criteria includes GPA, extracurricular activity and community involvement. **Must be postmarked by April 15, 2012.**

**OHIO FORESTRY ASSOCIATION MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP.** For students majoring in forest resource education in four-year college or two-year technical program. Application in Guidance. **Deadline April 15, 2012.**

**KHS ACADEMIC BOOSTERS SCHOLARSHIP.** \$500 scholarship to active KHS academic club or society member (Envirothon, Janus, Math-Academic Challenge, NHS, Science Olympiad, Speech and Debate). Must have a cumulative GPA of 3.5 or above and minimum ACT 25 or SAT 1200 (critical reading and math combined). Must include a sealed copy of your "official" KHS transcript (obtained from Guidance). One-page application in Guidance must be returned to Guidance or the Academic Boosters' mailbox **no later than April 16, 2012.**

**PAUL BRANDT ESCO-CLEVELAND SCHOLARSHIP.** LEAF scholarship is given to students with a minimum 3.0 GPA planning to study engineering. Must complete the FAFSA to apply and have two letters of recommendation, one being from a science or math teacher. Applications are in Guidance. They **must be received in the LEAF office no later than April 16, 2012.** No applications will be accepted after that date.

**CHAGRIN FALLS APPENDANT MASONIC SCHOLARSHIP.** Awards based on service, need, character, scholarship and leadership. Applications in Guidance – **due back to Guidance by April 19, 2012.**

**CREATIVE ARTISTS ASSOCIATION PORTFOLIO COMPETITION.** For students who will major in art in college. See details on the application form available in Guidance. **Portfolios must be mailed or delivered to be received by April 19, 2012.**

**CHAGRIN VALLEY ROTARY CLUB.** Both Academic and Vocational scholarships awarded based on need, community service, academic achievement and extracurricular activity. Apply online on our Kenston website, or get paper applications in Guidance. If you apply online, you need to print the last signature page, have a parent sign it, and mail it with your essay and a letter of recommendation per the instructions on the application form. **Deadline is April 23, 2012.**

**OHIO CREDIT UNION FOUNDATION VIDEO SCHOLARSHIP.** \$5,000 scholarship for video submission. Must be a member of an Ohio-based credit union in good standing. **Deadline April 26, 2012.**

**GEAUGA COUNTY MASTER GARDENERS ACADEMIC SCHOLARSHIP.** For students accepted at Ohio State University ATI in Wooster and planning to pursue a degree in horticulture, agriculture or related field. Requires reference letter and official transcript. **Must be mailed or delivered in person to be received by April 30, 2012.**

**LUBRIZOL CORP. MINORITY SCHOLARSHIP 2012.** Must be African-American, American Indian, Asian Pacific American or Hispanic American with a minimum 2.75 GPA and plan to study in the fields of: chemical or mechanical engineering, chemistry, polymer science, computer science, information systems management, business, accounting, finance or communication. Must not be a dependent of a Lubrizol employee. Applications are available in Guidance. **Must be mailed to be received no later than May 4, 2012.**

**NOVA SCHOLARSHIP FUND.** Renewable awards given based on financial need, complete the FAFSA, minimum 22 ACT or 1030 SAT, and plan to study engineering, manufacturing or information technologies, marketing or business. Applications in Guidance. **Must apply by May 15, 2012.**

**AMERICANS OF ITALIAN HERITAGE.** Must have at least one parent of Italian descent and have a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA. Three awards given, one in each category: 2.5-2.99 GPA, 3.0-3.5 GPA and above 3.5 GPA. **Must be mailed to be received by May 15, 2012.**

**HEALTHY LIFESTYLES SCHOLARSHIP.** \$5,000. Two essay questions. Apply at [www.studentscholarships.org](http://www.studentscholarships.org).

**ABBOTT & FENNER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM.** Awards up to \$1,000. Essay required. Apply at <http://www.abbottandfenner.com/scholarships.htm>. **Deadline to apply June 15, 2012.**
